# Canvas Quizzes for Large Classes (>200 Students)

Canvas quizzes for large classes (more than 200 students) may require additional settings to ensure smooth functionality and successful rendering of quiz statistics. It is also essential to note that having all students access the same quiz simultaneously can cause slowdowns in both the SpeedGrader and Gradebook. Please also be aware that there are no effective ways to detect or prevent using generative AI tools during take-home assessments.

To address the issue, the teaching team can consider two options:

Pros:  There is no need to stagger the start time among students.
Cons:  • There are multiple quizzes to manage and grade.  • The setup is manual and can be relatively



Below, we demonstrate the steps to set up the two options.


## Option 1: Staggering the start time for the same quiz

#### Manual Setup


- Let's say your course has 200 students, your quiz is 60 minutes long, and you will split the start time into 2 groups with one group starting 10 minutes after the first group
- 1. Scroll to the bottom of your Quiz Details tab to the Assign section




2. Set the availability window and the due date. Notice how the quiz is 60 minutes but the due date window is 30 minutes longer. This is the best practice since it helps ensure that all students have the full 60 minutes for their attempt if they start late for any reason (internet, time-zone, etc.). This also lowers the number of students trying to start the quiz at the same time.




3. Choose students to assign the quiz to



4. Add another Assign group and set up the times so that each option is later



5. For your last group you can assign it to *Everyone* and it will be assigned to *Everyone Else*. Make sure to save when you're done



# Option 2: Duplicating the quiz


• Click the 3 dots menu on the guiz you want to duplicate and click Copy To...




Choose your course and click Copy

end of the name.




• For each quiz, follow the steps in A to assign the deadline to a subset of students. **Make** sure none of them are assigned to *Everyone* 



## **Quiz Statistics**

- For large quizzes, quiz statistics will not be rendered directly in the Canvas interface.
- In order to access Quiz Statistics, each quiz should have <600 student attempts and <100
  questions. If this requirement is not met, you will not have the ability to view or even
  download quiz statistics.</li>
