



Zoom New Virtual Background Feature


Zoom version requirement

- Windows: 5.2.0 (42619.0804) or higher
- macOS: 5.2.0 (42634.0805) or higher
- Linux: 5.2.0 (440215.0803) or higher


1. Click the **Share Screen** button located in your meeting controls.




2. In the pop-up window, switch to **Advanced** tab




3. Here you are able to choose slides as Virtual Background, which is basically same as share content. After clicking on it, you are allowed to choose a PowerPoint file (.pptx form only) to share with students.




- Once the presentation has been imported, the slides will be shown as your virtual background. If your video is on, by default it will be imposed over the slides.



- You are able to switch your slides using navigation bar




- You can change the view of your video and slides by clicking the ... in the presentation menu.



- You can click and hold to resize or move the video image of yourself.



8. You can remove your video image from slides by choosing **Split Video from Slides**



Note: If a participant is on a version lower than what is stated above or joining from the Web client, a Zoom Room, or 3rd party endpoint, they will view the slides as a normal screen share, and the presenter's video will not be imposed over the slides.
